

DISMISSALS

Violations that may be dismissed if certain stipulations are met include:

- No Safety Responsibility (no proof of liability insurance)
- No Driver's License
- Fail to Display Driver's License
- Fail to Report Address Change on Driver's License
- Expired Driver's License
- Expired Vehicle Registration
- Expired Vehicle Inspection
- Defective Equipment

The violation may be dismissed if the following requirements are met:

- No Safety Responsibility – Provide to the court by appearance date proof of valid liability insurance that was in effect at the time and date of the citation. Documentation will be verified by the court.
- No Driver's License – Provide to the court by appearance date proof of valid driver's license.
- Fail to Display Driver's License – Provide to the court by appearance date proof of valid driver's license along with a dismissal fee in the amount of \$10.
- Fail to Report Address Change – Provide to the court within 20 working days from the date of citation proof that the address has been corrected along with a dismissal fee in the amount of \$20.
- Expired Driver's License – Provide to the court within 20 working days from the date of citation a copy of driver's license renewal along with a dismissal fee in the amount of \$20.
- Expired Vehicle Registration – Provide to the court within 20 working days from the date of citation a copy of the receipt received at the time of registration indicating a penalty was paid from the Tax Assessor-Collector's office along with a dismissal fee in the amount of \$20.
- Expired Vehicle Inspection – Was expired less than 60 days. Provide to the court within 20 working days from the date of citation a copy of the receipt from the Inspection station that indicates the date of inspection, vehicle inspected and amount paid for the inspection along with a dismissal fee in the amount of \$20.
- Defective Equipment – Provide to the court by appearance date proof of the equipment repair along with a dismissal fee in the amount of \$10. The receipt of proof MUST indicate the specific equipment repair for the specific vehicle cited.
