NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON TAX INCREASE

A tax rate of \$0.532462 per \$100 valuation has been proposed by the governing body of City of Lacy Lakeview.

PROPOSED TAX RATE	\$0.532462 per \$100
NO-NEW-REVENUE TAX RATE	\$0.323552 per \$100
VOTER-APPROVAL TAX RATE	\$0.483042 per \$100
DE MINIMIS RATE	\$0.548957 per \$100

The no-new-revenue tax rate is the tax rate for the 2024 tax year that will raise the same amount of property tax revenue for City of Lacy Lakeview from the same properties in both the 2023 tax year and the 2024 tax year.

The voter-approval rate is the highest tax rate that City of Lacy Lakeview may adopt without holding an election to seek voter approval of the rate, unless the de minimis rate for City of Lacy Lakeview exceeds the voter-approval rate for City of Lacy Lakeview.

The de minimis rate is the rate equal to the sum of the no-new-revenue maintenance and operations rate for City of Lacy Lakeview, the rate that will raise \$500,000, and the current debt rate for City of Lacy Lakeview.

The proposed tax rate is greater than the no-new-revenue tax rate. This means that City of Lacy Lakeview is proposing to increase property taxes for the 2024 tax year.

A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED TAX RATE WILL BE HELD ON August 26, 2024 AT 6:00 PM AT Lacy Lakeview Civic Center 503 E Craven Ave Lacy Lakeview TX 76705.

The proposed tax rate is greater than the voter-approval tax rate but not greater than the de minimis rate. However, the proposed tax rate exceeds the rate that allows voters to petition for an election under Section 26.075, Tax Code. If City of Lacy Lakeview adopts the proposed tax rate, the qualified voters of the City of Lacy Lakeview may petition the City of Lacy Lakeview to require an election to be held to determine whether to reduce the proposed tax rate. If a majority of the voters reject the proposed tax rate, the tax rate of the City of Lacy Lakeview will be the voter-approval tax rate of the City of Lacy Lakeview. WHEREAS, the City Council, through its budgetary process determined that

a total tax rate of \$0.532462 per \$100.00 valuation (the "Proposed Tax Rate") is necessary to enable the City to meet its necessary budgetary needs for the 2024-2025 fiscal year, and

WHEREAS, a notice to adopt the Proposed Tax Rate for 2024 was published as required by law.

WHEREAS, a public hearing on the Proposed Tax Rate was held;

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that this tax rate is in the best

interest of the citizens of the City of Lacy Lakeview;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE

CITY OF LACY LAKEVIEW, TEXAS:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Lacy Lakeview, Texas hereby levies and adopts the tax rate per \$100.00 valuation for this City for the tax year of 2024 as follows: 0.532462 dollars total tax rate per \$100.00 valuation.

THIS TAX RATE WILL RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR'S TAX RATE.

THE TAX RATE WILL EFFECTIVELY BE INCREASED BY 23.19 PERCENT AND WILL RAISE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS ON A \$100,000 HOME.

Section 2. The tax assessor/collector is hereby authorized to assess and collect the taxes of the City of Lacy Lakeview employing the above tax rate for year 2024.

Section 3. That the meeting at which this ordinance was approved was open to the public and conducted in compliance with the Texas Open Meetings Act, Texas Government Code Chapter 551.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall become effective immediately from and after its passage.
